Keynote Speaker

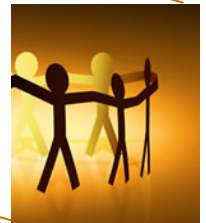

Venue

Trinity Chapel is located on the Macquarie University campus, at 136 Herring Rd, Macquarie Park. This is near the intersection of Waterloo and Herring Roads, diagonally opposite the Macquarie Centre and opposite the Macquarie University railway station.

Buses from the city, Parramatta, Epping, Eastwood, Chatswood and Blacktown service the Macquarie Centre.

The train service runs from Chatswood and Epping to Macquarie University station.

There is casual parking available in the Macquarie University car parks for \$18 per day. There is also parking at the Macquarie Centre (\$15 for 7 hrs, \$25 for > 7 hours). Free parking in the street is approximately 30 minutes walk away.
